What data do we collect?

Pembroke Karate Club collects the following data:

- Personal identification and contact information, such as Name, email address, phone number, etc. as per Application Forms.
- Malta Karate Federation details, World Karate Federation details, health status, medical conditions, injury reports.
- Guardian or parent details.
- Police conduct for 18+ members.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Pembroke Karate Club with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or fill in the Application Forms.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

Pembroke Karate Club may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources:

- Instagram, Facebook or other social media.

How will we use your data?

Pembroke Karate Club collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order and manage your account.
- Email you with special offers on other products and services we think you might like.

How do we store your data?

Pembroke Karate Club securely stores your data at Pembroke Karate Club premises (6, Jesmabel, Fra Giuseppe Zammit Street, Pembroke. Malta) only and are available only to authorized employees of Pembroke Karate Club.

Pembroke Karate Club will keep your data for 1 year after you finish your Malta Karate Federation Membership. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by destroying the Malta Karate Federation licence book (if not collected), printed records and deletion from the database. You have the right to request Pembroke Karate Club for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

What are your data protection rights?

Pembroke Karate Club would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Pembroke Karate Club for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Pembroke Karate Club corrects any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Pembroke Karate Club to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Pembroke Karate Club erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Pembroke Karate Club restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Pembroke Karate Club processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Pembroke Karate Club transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

Cookies

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behaviour information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology

How do we use cookies?

Pembroke Karate Club uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

What types of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses:

- **Functionality** – Pembroke Karate Club uses these cookies so that we recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and location you are in. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies are used.
- **Advertising** – Pembroke Karate Club uses these cookies to collect information about your visit to our website, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about your browser, device, and your IP address. Pembroke Karate Club sometimes shares some limited aspects of this data with third parties for advertising purposes. We may also share online data collected through cookies with our advertising partners. This means that when you visit another website, you may be shown advertising based on your browsing patterns on our website.

How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.
